### Conditions

Interested applicants must fulfill the following conditions:

1. Should be a South Sudanese citizen.
2. Sudan School Certificate of 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 with pass in seven subjects; at least 60% for science section and 65% for Arts section.
3. Applicants should attach a) original copy of Sudan School Certificate b) original copy of birth or age assessment certificate c) copy of nationality certificate d) 6 pictures of passport size e) copy of valid passport if available.

The scholarships are fully exempted from tuition fees. Students considered under these scholarships should be able to cater for the following expenses:

1. Air tickets;
2. Textbooks fees; and
3. Accommodation (lodging and feeding) during the studying period.

Application form can be picked and submitted at the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology, office of Admission next to Ministry of General Education as from Monday October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 to Friday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2011.
